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INTRODUCTION TO BIBLE PROPHECY

<u>Defined</u>: God declaring the history of tomorrow.

Bible prophecy is not prediction but rather revelation. Prediction would imply the possibility of the prophecy not being fulfilled. Revelation implies that the prophecy given is absolute without the option of not being fulfilled. Bible prophecy is absolute and is sure to be fulfilled.

SECOND The return of Jesus Christ to the earth with the intention of

COMING establishing his promised kingdom upon the earth.

RAPTURE The "catching away" of the church. The rapture is for those who have

placed their faith in the finished work of Jesus Christ and have been

born again. The rapture is for the church.

TRIBULATION The seven year period that follows the rapture of the church. The

Tribulation was prophesied in the Old Testament and is referred to as

the "Time of Jacob's Trouble" and the "Seventieth Week of Daniel".

MILLENNIUM The 1,000 year period that is the fulfillment of the Old Testament

Prophecy that the Lord will establish his kingdom on earth and Jesus

himself will literally rule and reign with a rod of iron.

RESURRECTION The bodily resurrection of all who have died. The dead in Christ will be

risen from the dead as well as those who are without Christ will be raised

up for the judgment at the Great White Throne.

DEATH There are two deaths; physical death and spiritual death. Physical death

comes when our body ceases to function. Spiritual death comes when we

are separated from God and it is ultimately realized when death and hell

are cast into the lake of fire.

- 1. Before the promises of God to Abraham, Christ was in existence.
- 2. This passage connects the work of Christ in the gospel to the law in Exodus.

- 1. Christ was active in creation and was the key character in creation.
- 2. Christ was before all of creation. Thus, his birth was introduction not creation.

It is important to understand that even though the birth of Christ was a fulfillment of prophecy, it was not his beginning. Jesus Christ was before creation, before the fall of man and before the prophecy of Scripture. Jesus was not God's response to a problem but rather the fruition of God's perfect plan.





ISRAEL SUSTAINED - IN SPITE OF SIN

ISRAEL'S PATTERN - JUDGES 2:11-20

- 1. Children of Israel did evil in the sight of the LORD
- 2. Forsook the LORD God of their fathers
- **3.** Followed other gods
- 4. Provoked the LORD to anger.
- 5. The anger of the LORD was hot against Israel
- 6. He delivered them into the hands of spoilers that spoiled them
- 7. He sold them into the hands of their enemies round about
 - * They could not any longer stand before their enemies.

Long-Term Impact: Whithersoever they went out,

- 1) The hand of the LORD was against them for evil
- 2) They were greatly distressed.

Over their history, Israel developed a pattern of sin, separation, desperation and redemption with God.

One of the amazing truths about God is that in spite of all their sin, his "hand was stretched out still". (Isaiah 5:25)

ISRAEL SUSTAINED - IN SPITE OF SIN

GOD'S CONTINUED FAVOR - JUDGES 2:17-20

- 1. Nevertheless the LORD raised up judges, which delivered them
 - * Yet they would not hearken unto their judges, but
 - * They went a whoring after other gods, and bowed themselves unto them:
 - * They turned quickly out of the way which their fathers walked in,
- 2. When the LORD raised them up judges, then the LORD was with the judge, and delivered them out of the hand of their enemies all the days of the judge:
- **Why?** It repented the LORD because of their groanings by reason of them that oppressed them and vexed them.

ISRAEL RETURNS TO SIN - JUDGES 2:19-20

- 3. When the judge was dead
 - * They returned
 - * Corrupted themselves more than their fathers, in following other gods to serve them,
 - * Bow down unto them; they ceased not from their own doings, nor from their stubborn way.
- **4.** The anger of the LORD was hot against Israel; and he said, Because that this people hath transgressed my covenant which I commanded their fathers, and have not hearkened unto my voice;
- This pattern would tragically continue throughout the life of Israel and they would have ceased to exist if it were not for the sustaining promises of God.

The Tribulation is the "time of Jacob's trouble" not the time of the "churches trouble".

Genesis 7:6-9 And Noah was six hundred years old when the flood of waters was upon the earth. And Noah went in ... because of the waters of the flood. Genesis 8:1 And God remembered Noah

* As Noah went through the flood and emerged alive and well on the other side, Israel will go through the judgment of the Tribulation and not be spared but will emerge at the conclusion of the Tribulation and assume their position in the Millennial Kingdom.

Challenges: Pre-tribulation rapture theology existed in the eighteenth century with the Puritan preacher Increase and Cotton Mather and was popularized extensively in the 1830s by John Nelson Darby and the Plymouth Brethren, and further in the United States by the wide circulation of the Scofield Reference Bible in the early 20th century.

- * Many who disparage the idea of the rapture will claim that it is a new doctrine.
- * Our Response: The Rapture was the doctrinal position of the apostles/early church.

THE RAPTURE - LESSONS AND IMPACT

- *5:5 The Lion of the tribe of Judah ... hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.

- 1. First Seal: A White Horse He went forth conquering and to conquer

The Seven seals are opened and judgment is passed on the earth. Four horses. Revelation 5-6

The Seven Trumpet Judgments begin. The earth is judged and millions die. Revelation 8-9

The Great War in heaven between Michael and his angels and Satan and his angels. Satan cast out. Revelation 12:1-9

The vial judgments begin. The earth becomes unrecognizable. Revelation 16

The Marriage Supper of the Lamb. Believers prepare for battle. Revelation 19

The Beast ascends to power, brings peace and requires his mark on all mankind.

144,000 Jews, 12,000 out of every tribe of Israel are sealed. Revelation 7:1-8

God's two witnesses begin their ministry and they prophesy for 3.5 years. They are killed, viewed for three days and arise.
